



Nissan Community College Summer Internship Program

Nissan North America and Central Mississippi Planning and Development District are partnering to give students from the Industrial Maintenance programs at Copiah-Lincoln, Hinds, Holmes, and Southwest Community Colleges an opportunity to obtain firsthand training and experience. The students will participate in training with mechanics, technicians, and mechanical systems specialists. With this experience, students will receive educational skills and training to elevate their skill set, boosting job performance and closing any existing skills gaps. The industrial and mechanical training course programs are designed to meet the needs of employees and their future employers. Various topical programs, from hydraulic systems repair and maintenance training to mechanical training for field service technicians, promote self-paced, flexible learning experiences guided by industry expert coursework.

1. Who can apply to the Nissan Summer Community College Internship Program?

Students who have completed a minimum of one year of coursework in their program of study with a preference of three completed semesters of coursework by Spring 2024 are eligible.

2. Are internships paid?

Yes. Internships are paid and benchmarked to ensure competitive rates.
